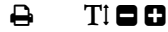


Proposal Announced to Frack for Natural Gas Using Propane

Tioga Co. (18 NEWS) -- "It's time for action," that's what Kevin Frisbie, the President of the Tioga County Farmers Bureau is saying in reference to a proposal this morning. That proposal was to frack for natural gas in the town of Barton, N.Y. using gelled propane and sand.

It's a technology Frisbie claims is outside the scope of the hydrofracking ban, and something that should be implemented.

"It meets all the regulations. There's no real reason why it wouldn't be approved and now we think, those of us, in this group that the time has come, studying is time is over. Time to start the process now," he says.
